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Legislative Proposals on Georgia's Tax Incentives

On February 7, Lt. Governor Burt Jones and Speaker of the House Jon Burns held a press conference on legislative initiatives addressing proposed reforms of several tax incentive programs.

"Georgians deserve to have transparency and a clear picture of how their taxpayer dollars are being spent, while knowing which industries receive tax breaks and in what amounts," **said Lieutenant Governor Burt Jones**. "I want to thank Speaker Burns, Chairmen Hufstetler and Blackmon, and all of the members of the subcommittee who reviewed our tax incentive programs in 2023. As a result of their work, the Georgia General Assembly will have the opportunity to consider a tax reform package that lowers taxes for Georgia families and businesses, provides more transparency, and tightens requirements for several major incentive programs."

Lt. Governor Burt Jones' priorities for Tax Reform are Senate Bill 349 and Senate Bill 366.

- Legislation: <u>Senate Bill 349</u> "Save our Homes Act" - Limits year-to-year increases in home values for local property taxes to 3 percent, regardless of assessed value.
- Legislation: <u>Senate Bill 366</u> "Tax Expenditures Transparency Act" -Addresses legislative recommendations proposed by the Joint Subcommittee reviewing Georgia's current state tax credits, deductions, and exemptions.
